Artichoke Dip

Serves 12

- 1 (16 ounce) can artichoke hearts
- 8 ounces mozzarella cheese, shredded
- 1 cup Parmesan cheese, grated
- 1 cup mayonnaise
- Dash of garlic powder

Combine all ingredients; stir and pour into an 8" square Pyrex dish. Bake at 325 degrees for 20 to 25 minutes, until golden brown. Note: This can be made ahead and refrigerated.
