NCCC and NCM Happenings

NCCC West Coast Regional Governors Meeting—May 17, 2007

Regional Treasurer's report

Ellis Chee gave the Treasure's report as of May 15, 2007.

Regional Membership Director's Report

Cliff Harris reports that NCCC is going electronic. All Secretary's Report of all Governor's Meetings in St. Louis will be on the computer from now on. This will be displayed on the NCCC web site. Sounds like NCCC is going the way CSS is doing with our newsletter to save cost.

Term limits of several national officers are up for election. For those interested the positions of Secretary, Vice President of Competition and Sergeants of Arm are available. If you are interested contact our Regional Executive Allen Morris.

There's been a big problem with this year's NCCC packages. Many have been returned for ripped open packages due to the pins within the envelopes. All packages are sent first class and when the contents are missing or ripped open they are returned to the sender. If you are one of these people please have patient and it will be resolved soon.

Pins and calendars will be going back into the packages. There's been a debate over dropping pins and calendars off the packages because of cost; (plus the above statement), but the people who want them back in won over.

New NCCC application forms are available and I did forward a small amount to Teresa Cruz. They now include the new member's e-mail address. There's been problems with some people's addresses and they now want their e-mail for more effective communication with the members.

Regional Competition Director's Report

Les Rajciz reports that there are 33 sanctioned events schedule so far for this year. The first 3 sanctioned events have been completed. WCR Competition Points as of May 12, 2007 can be found on the CSS web page.

Clubs must send out results of each sanctioned event to each contestant (one per couple) in letter form or e-mail.

NCCC web-site has instructions, forms and examples of event results. Flyers must be sent out to every club (15 Regions) by the RCD. Use only accepted NCCC format!

All club event workers must be accounted for in order to get the "events worker" points of 2. This goes into the sum of the club's competition points.

NCCC convention competition; C4, C5 & C6, are required to remove all moveable items from the wheels for all autocross events. Their reason for this is to prevent center caps from knocking over cones. ??????

When you enter a stock event, your car must be completely stock period. Even exhaust systems, oversized tires will must up to a different class.

High Speed Certificates requires 10 autocrosses. We only have 5 autocross events this year; however Spring Mountain Corvette Days, Willow Springs and the like can be counted.

NCCC event fees. Les reminds us of the required fees for non-sanctioned events; NCCC member free, non-NCCC member pays \$2.00. Sanctioned events; NCCC members pay \$1.00 and non-NCCC member pays \$2.00. This is mailed to the RCD with result and he forwards it the RT for deposit into the WCR bank account.

Les will stay on as RCD through out this year if no one volunteers to take it over. He will not be available for next year. He claims he will be doing more competition events instead of being the RCD. The job is open to volunteers. How about it Ed Norris or Dave Alciatore? Here's your chance; you'll have to voted in of course and we may have a special election. The floor was open for any volunteers and

Rolyn Grim of the new club Corvette of Choice volunteered. Les will write-up requirements for the job soon. **We need more volunteers.** It does require traveling all day Friday to get to St. Louis, MO for the 4 meetings per year. Since meeting schedules are known far in advance; flight reservations can be made 90 days prior to the meeting at reduced prices. All trips to St Louis are reimbursed by NCCC for the flight, meals, mileage to and from airport and room. WCR even pays \$150.00 for each trip. It's been reported that you can even make money on some of these trips. Come on you guys; jump in on a good thing, especially you retire people.
