#### <u>"WHAT'S MY CORVETTE WORTH?"</u>

Everyone who owns a Corvette wants to know how much it is worth. You can look up on the phone APP "Corvette

DNA" to find out the value. Most people don't know that a Corvette is worth more in parts than it is as a whole. "You're Crazy", some would say. BUT IT IS A FACT!

Corvette salvage companies specialize in buying wrecked Vettes and "parting them out."

For example, a 2010 Corvette coupe costs about \$50,000 new. But used it would be valued at about \$35,000. However, if the total parts of the car were sold separately, it would add up to over \$60,000.

Here is a partial list of the parts of the 2010 and what they would cost used:

1. L53 6.2 liter Engine	\$6,500
2. Hood Assembly	\$500
3. Headlight Assembly	\$625 each
4. Front Wheels and Tires	\$ 1,400 for pair
5. Seats	\$ 1,500 a pair
6. Six-Speed manual Transaxle	\$ 1,500
7. Automatic Transaxle	\$ 1,200
8. Decklid with glass	\$850
9. Taillight	\$60 each

These are some examples of prices listed from a dismantler company. Your prices may be higher or lower.

This only gives food for thought for your Corvette. I'm not saying that when you get ready to sell your "ride", you part it out. We should leave this to the professional dismantlers.

This does make one think: "just how much is my car worth"? But please don't wreck it to find out!!!



#### **Extreme Autocross - Montana**

I had the opportunity to drive 3 very special autocross courses while visiting Will and Joyce Grohmann over the Fourth of July this year. CSS members Will and Joyce have several cabins 20 miles north east of Wilsall Montana and it's an exquisite place beyond the fact that the roads in the area are amazing autocross courses. But I am getting ahead of myself.

The vehicle of choice for these amazing courses are ATVs and NOT Corvettes due to the 5<sup>th</sup> Commandment of the Corvette 10 Commandments that state that "Thou shalt not drive Corvette on unpaved roads." But, don't let that fool you. The 4 wheel drive Polaris machines can get up to the low speed autocross limits if need be and I did!

There are 3 major courses, one for each level of driver from novice to intermediate to expert. The novice course is flat, short and has easy turns. The intermediate course is more technical, with hair pin turns, a longer course and small hills. The expert course is much longer with radical hills, hair pin turns at the bottoms and five miles each way. This course is hard enough going uphill but the reverse course down the hill can make your heart skip a beat. I remember Bud going around a turn at high speed at Pahrump and going off course and failing the cardinal rule at Spring Mountain which is keep the tires on the black top. Here though I guarantee that leaving the road could be disastrous unless you know how to fly!

All three courses can be run individually for time or lug nut to lug nut like Joe's time trials at Pahrump. After practicing both ways on the novice and intermediate courses I felt I was ready for the lug nut race on the expert course

Now it is important to say that I would never have attempted these were it not for Cindy Orrico a long time ago convincing me to try auto crossing at Vapor Trails Vettes in Santa Maria. She said try it once and if you don't like it don't do it again. I tried once and was hooked. I also need to thank Joe, and both Ed and Bud Norris for their never ending training at every autocross I ever entered. Bud and Ed helped me learn how to find the proper line on the course and where to be before and after turns. Joe taught me how to understand the apex of turns and how to use the rumble strips to my advantage. Unfortunately the technique of heel toe brake gas clutch does not apply since these are more like motorcycles with four all-wheel drive.

I would recommend visiting Will and Joyce in Montana whenever you can. Not only is the land more beautiful than California but the rivers are running full, there are wild animals everywhere, there are wild flowers everywhere no traffic noise and open spaces that all renew your spirits. Will has built his log cabins by hand even his three story one on 100 acres. Will and Joyce are wonderful hosts and might just let you win an autocross or two.

#### **Where You Can Find Corvette Parts and Merchandise**

For those of you who have been into Corvettes for awhile most – or all – of the following will not be news to you, but for you relative newcomers to the love of Vettes this offering is being made to help you find the parts you may need for your classic or the trim add-ons you might want to buy to personalize your Vette or the clothing, gear, etc. you might like to own to show others of your interest in the sport.

It's amazing just how many publications are out there that are dedicated to Corvettes and how helpful many of them can be. Following is a list and quick summary of the more popular catalogs that you might want to look into. Most of them are available for routine periodic mailing if you request it, and most of them have a web site from which you can peruse their offerings. Me, I prefer to receive the catalogs so that I can better see just what's out there I might not have not seen before.

The three largest, most popular catalogs with the most items that are non-"parts" are:

- a. Mid America Motorworks, <u>www.mamotorworkscom</u>, (800) 500-1500;
- b. Eckler's Corvette, www.ecklersCorvette.com, (800) 327-4868;
- c. Corvette America, <u>www.CorvetteAmerica.com</u>, (800) 458-3475.

Those publications periodically also publish catalogs geared specifically for a single generation of Corvettes so when they ask you for the year and model you drive don't be afraid to tell them.

Then there are catalogs that are almost exclusively for parts, especially of older model Corvettes:

- a. Volunteer Vette Products, www.volvette.com, (865) 521-9100;
- b. J & D Corvette, www.jdcorvette.com, (800) 838-8353 (located locally in Bellflower, CA).

For trim and accessory items as well as clothes, furniture and the like, you should look at:

- a. Corvette Central, <a href="www.CorvetteCentral.com">www.CorvetteCentral.com</a>, (800) 345-4122. They have an accessories catalog and a separate catalog of parts, etc., for each generation of Corvettes.
- b. Burston Marketing's Corvette Collection, www.CorvetteCollection.com, (800) 653-1375.
- c. And finally, the catalog from the retail store at the National Corvette Museum, www.CorvetteMuseum.org, (800) 538-3883.

In addition to the above, you might also consider visiting the show rooms of Corvette Mike's at 1133 North Tustin Avenue and West Coast Corvettes, 1210 N. Kraemer Blvd., both are located near each other in Anaheim just off the 91 freeway in Anaheim. They have a selection of GM authorized accessories and clothes for sale, as well as an indoor Corvette sales room with used road gems. Both also maintain service departments for installing accessories and the like and for general maintenance of Corvettes. West Coast Corvettes has a new catalog that was just released and is available for pick-up at the store. (Price is pre-printed on each catalog as \$12.95, but don't be fooled, they're free - just ask for one.)






