Our trip to the Midwest is over and we are back home. Five weeks in the 2012 Corvette and averaging over 30 MPG isn't bad for a performance car!

The main reason we took the Corvette was to attend the "Bloomington Gold Corvette Show in Bloomington, Illinois. This was the 50<sup>th</sup> year of this show and it returned to its original home of the show in Bloomington.

The show was held on June 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> at Illinois State University. They used University Buildings for the different venues and displays. The Arena is where over 50 Corvettes were being judged for awards. The College Field House had indoor venders and displays. There was a large Swap Meet area with car parts and literature being sold and a parking area for all 1973 Corvettes – the 50-year-old ones.

The Premier Gold Collection was a salute to the Corvette Z06. These were famous racers, big tanks, special editions, and a couple of 2023 low mile new Z06's. There were also 13 1963 Z06's; the year the Z06 was produced. To highlight a couple of these early Z06's was one of the first off of the assembly line in St Louis in September 1962. The one important car was a 1963 Z06 with a big tank, a big motor and big brakes and it came from Don Steve's Chevrolet Dealership in La Habra, California. I spoke to the owner, Brad Jeager from Ohio and gave him the "Rest of the Story" ... Dave MacDonald, a Southern California Corvette racer sponsored by Don Steve's, and went to St. Louis and picked up the 1st Z06 off the assembly line and drove it back to Los Angeles.

There were 16 Z06's, several late model Corvettes, all with special options in the Gold Collection. Mark Grimm from Morton, Illinois brought his 2011 Z06 that he found in 2016. The Dealer didn't know how special this car was and Mark bought it for a very low price.

These special Corvette Shows are an important part of the history of the Corvette. Try to attend some of these shows.

Membership Secretary, Sherry Anderson, shared that we have 83 members.



### Who is Tom Horton?

Tom is a Vietnam veteran who also served in-country. He drives a 2012 Super Sonic Blue C6, his third. A 1961 was the first and a 1977 was the second.

Tom was born in Aurora, Illinois and moved to California at age 14. After graduating from Savanna High School, he took a job with Pacific Bell as a Lineman. He held that job until he was invited in 1965 to join the US Army. The Army said the lineman experience was a valuable skill, and ordered him to Vietnam, Long Binh Post ("Pentagon East"). He experienced multiple jobs from convoy driving to laying phone lines.

The Army discharged him and he bought his first Corvette. He enrolled at CSU Fullerton as an Accounting Major. He graduated in 1972. Meanwhile, he took up counting blackjack cards at Las Vegas casinos. "I never won too much at one table. I moved to another casino before my winnings were large enough to be noticed," he said. The casinos never caught onto him. "It was work and the feeling of winning never offset the feeling of losing. I stopped when gambling was no longer interesting. I never went back." He opened a travel agency business. It was successful, but was more work than he wanted. He now practices retirement.

He and Tina joined CSS in June 2021. Molly, 11-year-old Golden Retriever, is a regular companion at the monthly CSS parking lot gathering. He enjoys CSS meetings and chatting. The miniature golf

tournament is his favorite.

For CSS, he served as Secretary/Membership in 2022. Now he is Treasurer.

For those of you who have been into Corvettes for awhile most – or all – of the following will not be news to you, but for you relative newcomers to the love of Vettes this offering is being made to help you find the parts you may need for your classic or the trim add-ons you might want to buy to personalize your Vette or the clothing, gear, etc. you might like to own to show others of your interest in the sport.

It's amazing just how many publications are out there that are dedicated to Corvettes and how helpful many of them can be. Following is a list and quick summary of the more popular catalogs that you might want to look into. Most of them are available for routine periodic mailing if you request it, and most of them have a web site from which you can peruse their offerings. Me, I prefer to receive the catalogs so that I can better see just what's out there I might not have not seen before.

The three largest, most popular catalogs with the most items that are non-"parts" are:

For trim and accessory items as well as clothes, furniture and the like, you should look at:

- a. Corvette Central, <a href="www.CorvetteCentral.com">www.CorvetteCentral.com</a>, (800) 345-4122. They have an accessories catalog and a separate catalog of parts, etc., for each generation of Corvettes.
- b. Burston Marketing's Corvette Collection, www.CorvetteCollection.com, (800) 653-1375.
- c. And finally, the catalog from the retail store at the National Corvette Museum, <a href="https://www.corvetteMuseum.org">www.corvetteMuseum.org</a>, (800) 538-3883.

In addition to the above, you might also consider visiting the show rooms of Corvette Mike's at 1133 North Tustin Avenue and West Coast Corvettes, 1210 N. Kraemer Blvd., both are located near each other in Anaheim just off the 91 freeway in Anaheim. They have a selection of GM authorized accessories and clothes for sale, as well as an indoor Corvette sales room with used road gems. Both also maintain service departments for installing accessories and the like and for general maintenance of Corvettes. West Coast Corvettes has a new catalog that was just released and is available for pick-up at the store. (Price is pre-printed on each catalog as \$12.95, but don't be fooled, they're free - just ask for one.)




















