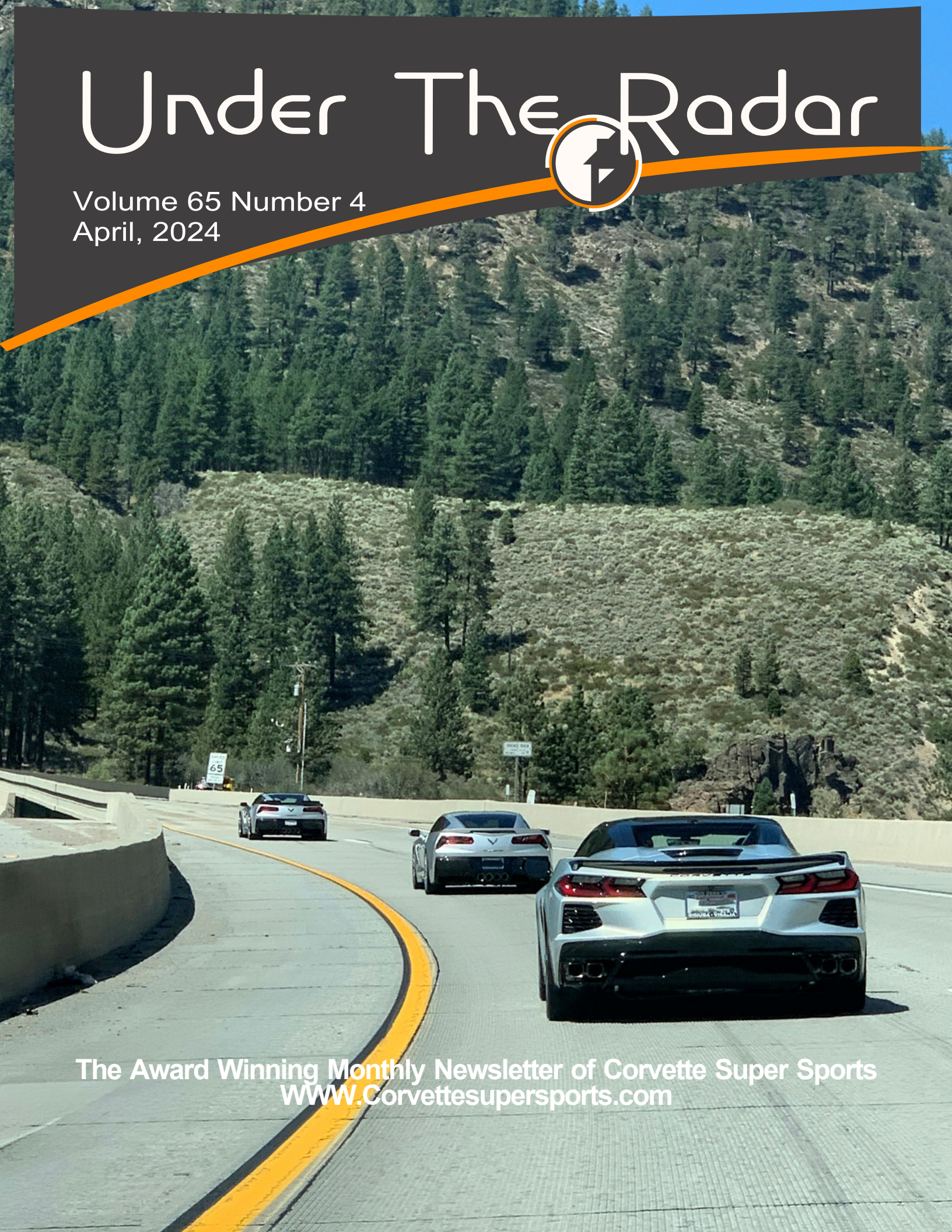

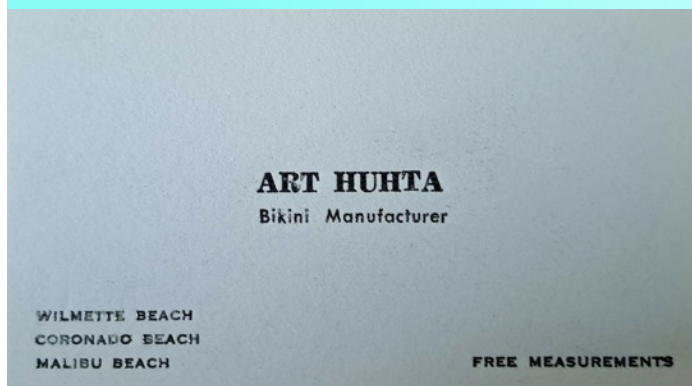
During the April CSS Board meeting, Debbie, Newsletter Editor, said business cards are welcome on the web site. Gee, I thought, I have a business card. It will be fun to put it out there.

My card originated when in 1966 I was an unmarried, Navy Ltjg. USN Patrol Squadron Fifty (VP50) was responsible for Vietnam coastal interdiction patrols from the DMZ to Cambodia. Two aircraft (Martin Marlin SP5B seaplane) were airborne 24/7. We launched north and south from Cam Ranh Bay. Sea Plane tenders (e.g. USS Pine Island AV12) were anchored to provide housing, meals and bullet hole repairs. Bullet holes below the water line are undesirable. Water takeoffs and landings were rough. Sitting in the water tied to a buoy, the salt water corroded the hull. We dealt with the tropical humidity and heat. After weeks of flying, my aircraft needed to dry off and required maintenance. We returned to Naval Air Station Sangley Point at Cavite on Manila Bay where the SP5B would be pulled onto shore. The evolution to bring it onshore is an interesting story for another time.

One night Dan Shumaker and I were enjoying San Miguel beer at the officer's club. We were looking forward to the end of the deployment and our return to San Diego. The dating scene was competitive, and we needed a smooth intro to the young ladies. Humor and laughs always works. After considering ideas, we decided to print cards "Bikini Manufacturer Free Measurements." This would be fun and a real hoot.

A couple of months later our WesPac deployment was over and we returned to Naval Air Station North Island. My good friend, James Clark, an E1B Airborne Early Warning officer, and future bride Marilyn said I should meet Margie Blackman. A cautious man, Jim warned her that I had just finished my second seven-month deployment with no feminine companions. Also, he warned that my sense of humor was different.

We met at the Marine Corps Recruit Depot Officer's Bar. Jim, Marilyn and Marge walked through the crowd and introduced us. She was beautiful! She had just graduated from SDSU and was Marilyn's sorority sister. She was lovely! I gave her a card. She looked at it and wondered about the jumbled name. Was it real? I had to explain my Finnish heritage. We talked and danced. It was love at first sight. We dated for two weeks straight until I was assigned Squadron Duty Officer, a 24-hour gig. Then dated more. Six months later, we were married. That was 56 years ago. The business cards were never used again until now.

For those of you who have been into Corvettes for awhile most – or all – of the following will not be news to you, but for you relative newcomers to the love of Vettes this offering is being made to help you find the parts you may need for your classic or the trim add-ons you might want to buy to personalize your Vette or the clothing, gear, etc. you might like to own to show others of your interest in the sport.

It's amazing just how many publications are out there that are dedicated to Corvettes and how helpful many of them can be. Following is a list and quick summary of the more popular catalogs that you might want to look into. Most of them are available for routine periodic mailing if you request it, and most of them have a web site from which you can peruse their offerings. Me, I prefer to receive the catalogs so that I can better see just what's out there I might not have not seen before.

The three largest, most popular catalogs with the most items that are non-“parts” are:

Those publications periodically also publish catalogs geared specifically for a single generation of Corvettes so when they ask you for the year and model you drive don't be afraid to tell them.

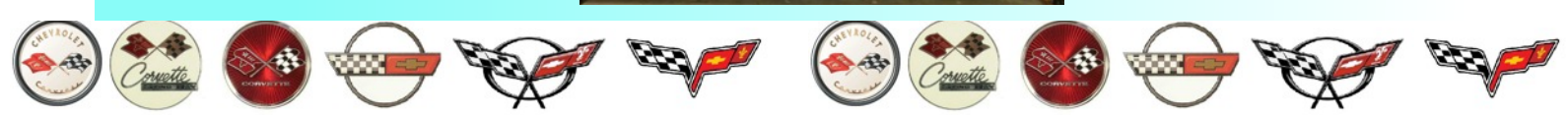
Then there are catalogs that are almost exclusively for parts, especially of older model Corvettes:

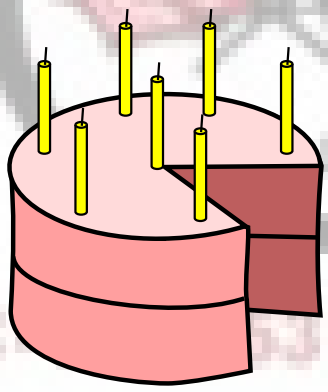

- c. And finally, the catalog from the retail store at the National Corvette Museum, www.CorvetteMuseum.org, (800) 538-3883.

In addition to the above, you might also consider visiting the show rooms of Corvette Mike's at 1133 North Tustin Avenue and West Coast Corvettes, 1210 N. Kraemer Blvd., both are located near each other in Anaheim just off the 91 freeway in Anaheim. They have a selection of GM authorized accessories and clothes for sale, as well as an indoor Corvette sales room with used road gems. Both also maintain service departments for installing accessories and the like and for general maintenance of Corvettes. West Coast Corvettes has a new catalog that was just released and is available for pick-up at the store. (Price is pre-printed on each catalog as \$12.95, but don't be fooled, they're free - just ask for one.)
