Then there are catalogs that are almost exclusively for parts, especially of older model Corvettes:

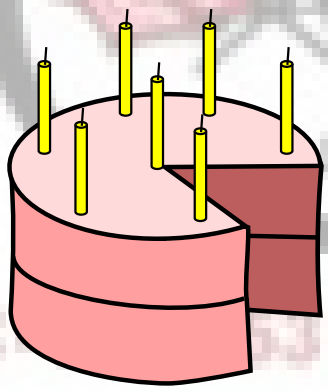
